



Calling Your Heart

My dear daughters of God and sisters in Christ. How beloved you are by our Creator and faithful Father! You are in His constant view and deeply within His heart. He loves you better than any good father could, and certainly more than those fathers who fail us. His love for you is beyond comparison. It is completely unique, and it is important that you know this deep within your soul and learn to personally experience it. That is the purpose of this gathering: that you receive the blessing of His deeper presence in your life and receive His love in a fresh and nurturing way.

I have discovered that I must withdraw from my activities and the rhythms of life that accompany me during my normal days, to find that deeper time with God. At best, there are only moments of relief and joyful occasions that refresh my soul in my normal pace of life. I am the last on my list to consider the need for such "wasted time," as I have thought of it in my past. I have discovered that it is not wasted time. It is wisely invested time to find out who God is and what I mean to Him. Are you like me? Are you nodding your head and saying, "He's talking about me!" I likely am, for it is a common problem with busy people. That is why we need an opportunity such as you are about to have, to sync with the Lover of your Soul and hear Him speak to you.

Our Global Board has been praying for a long time about this time you are about to experience. There are spiritual sisters of yours that you have never met before who will be traveling far and wide to share this experience with you. Many of them have been praying for you and this Summit for months. Many of the women you will meet will travel from different parts of our country. Some will fly over the Atlantic Ocean from Africa to be with you. Some will travel over the Caribbean Ocean from Colombia, South America and Costa Rica to be with you. Some speak in languages you do not understand, as well they will not understand you. That is why there will be translators who bridge the communication challenge with you. But there is one common language that you all can speak. You can speak with the language of the human heart, and it is this often quiet expression without words that is caught and received ... and loved.

I pray that you will both receive and give this love of Christ that will flow to you, and from you to your fellow sisters. I pray that the language of the human heart will show in your smiles, in your countenance, in your acts of kindness and tender heart to one another. I pray that you will experience love from all sources that will nurture your souls, for it is needed.

I will share one last personal discovery. It is not the act of doing the right thing that reveals a natural expression of love and kindness. It is the abundant and overflowing grace of God that we allow into our hearts that does it. It is from this that the expression becomes natural, for it flows from Him. So, I ask you dear sisters. Will you open your hearts and allow the love of God to fill you and envelope you, and then let it flow outward? That is what we are praying will happen to you and all the women in this gathering.

God bless you during the marvelous time you are about to experience. I'll see you there.

Él las ama más que cualquier buen padre, y ciertamente más que aquellos padres que nos fallan. Su amor por ustedes es incomparable. Es completamente único, y es importante que lo reconozcan en lo más profundo de su alma y aprendan a experimentarlo personalmente. Ese es el propósito de esta reunión: que reciban la bendición de su presencia más profunda en sus vidas y reciban su amor de una manera renovada y enriquecedora.

He descubierto que debo retirarme de mis actividades y del ritmo de vida que me acompaña en mis días normales, para encontrar ese tiempo más profundo con Dios. Probablemente sí, porque es un problema común en la gente ocupada. Por eso necesitamos una oportunidad como la que estás a punto de tener: conectar con el Amante de tu Alma y escucharlo hablarte.

Nuestra Junta Directiva Global ha estado orando durante mucho tiempo por este momento que estás a punto de experimentar. 
Jessica Smith

Bryan Craig


